ENERGY EFFICIENCY AND COST SAVINGS

Energy-Efficient Lighting

- ✓ Replace halogen bulbs with LED lighting for longer lifespan and lower power consumption.
- ✓ Use special veterinary LED operating lights that combine energy efficiency with bright, clear illumination.
- ✓ Install motion sensors and daylight detectors to ensure lights are on only when needed—especially useful during night emergency care.

Effective Cleaning Protocols

TWO-BUCKET METHOD



This method uses two buckets—one with cleaning solution and one empty. A cloth is dipped, wrung out over the empty bucket, used to wipe, then wrung again. To avoid contaminating the solution, use a fresh cloth each time.

THREE-BUCKET METHOD



This method adds a third bucket with clean water to rinse the cloth before dipping it back into the cleaning solution, preventing re-contamination and reducing cloth use.
